## Switzerland Annual Camp 2007

So there are only 24 weeks left until 13th Galway's trip to Switzerland. On June 28th the scout section will fly out for 8 days of fun and mayhem in Adelboden.

There will be 32 people traveling in total which includes 11 leaders at present. With more than 46 years of scout leading experience we promise that we will try our best not to loose your child abroad!!!

With only 5 full months remaining before we leave the leaders are asking that parents encourage the scouts to pay for the trip in installments. Payments can be made ever week and this will cut down substantially on the amount to be paid in June.

Some other things that parents need to consider are the following:

- Each scout must have

their own personal passport

- Each scout must have a EHIC card in order to travel, this can be gotten from the Western Health Board and is free of charge
- Each scout must have attend the determined number of events

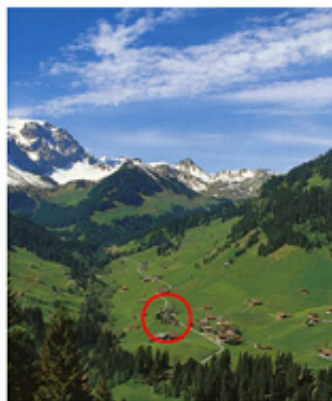
Everyone going on camp '07 has paid €100 so far, however before the 30th March each person will have to have paid €300. The remainder, which is thought to be ABOUT
